

Cataraqui Conservation Foundation Photo Contest 2017

Sponsored by Camera Kingston

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The contest is open to permanent and part-time residents of the Cataraqui Conservation Region of amateur status, that is, to those who derive less than 10 percent of their income from photography. Employees of the Cataraqui Region Conservation Authority, members of the Cataraqui Conservation Foundation, or employees of any contest sponsor are not eligible.
2. An entry form must accompany all entries. Entry forms may be picked up at the Cataraqui Region Conservation Authority Administration Office, 1641 Perth Road, Kingston, or Camera Kingston, 114 Princess St., Kingston, or downloaded at <http://www.cataraquiconservationfoundation.org/>
3. Entries must be received at Camera Kingston, 114 Princess Street, **between April 1, 2017 to May 31, 2017.**
4. All work submitted must be of original composition. Any print that is a copy or a recognized plagiarism of another photographer's work will be disqualified.
5. The theme for this year is "Getting Close to Nature". Entries will be judged on:
 - 1) artistic impression
 - 2) technical composition
 - 3) depiction of the theme
6. All photos must have been taken within the Cataraqui Conservation Region.
7. All photographs must be the work of the exhibitor and tagged with the photographer's name, address, phone number.

8. Entries (including digital) must be printed in 8 X 10 or 8 X 12 format at Camera Kingston, 114 Princess Street, and there will be an entry fee of \$5.00 per entry (tax included), which includes the print. Participants may submit up to four entries.

9. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st – One-year complimentary pass worth \$80 to the Conservation Area from the CRCA and a \$100 gift certificate from Camera Kingston

2nd - One-year complimentary pass worth \$80 to the Conservation Area from the CRCA and a \$75 gift certificate from Camera Kingston

3rd - \$50 gift certificate from Camera Kingston

4th - \$25 gift certificate from Camera Kingston

10. Final judging will take place prior to June 30, 2017. Decisions of the judges will be final. All finalist pictures will be displayed at the Little Cataraqui Regional Conservation Area or any suitable place selected by the Cataraqui Conservation Foundation or Conservation Authority. Winners will be notified after judging.

11. Entries shall become the property of the Cataraqui Conservation Foundation.

12. The Cataraqui Conservation Foundation and the Cataraqui Region Conservation Authority retain the right to reproduce any of the photos for the purposes of promotion and advancement. Negatives or digital files for selected entries must be made available to the Foundation and/or Conservation Authority for duplication at their request.

13. Model releases, if applicable, shall be the sole responsibility of the photographer.
